Audubon Society of Kalamazoo Education Grant Program

The Audubon Society of Kalamazoo is dedicated to bird and wildlife conservation, nature education and outdoor recreation. *These grants are made available through a generous bequest from Virginia Maxwell*.

Purpose of Grants: To provide financial assistance that will help students learn about and experience the natural world. Projects need not be directly related to birds. However, preference will be given to projects that include birds and/or outdoor experiences.

Eligibility: Applicant may be an educator, student (with an adult school-related sponsor), volunteer, support staff or paraprofessional working with elementary and middle school (K-8) students in a school setting within the following public school districts: Climax-Scotts, Comstock, Galesburg-Augusta, Gull Lake, Kalamazoo, Mattawan, Otsego, Parchment, Plainwell, Portage, Schoolcraft, Vicksburg. One grant is available per classroom/group per school year. Note: The grant money will be awarded to the sponsoring organization (a school, for example) and earmarked for the specific project.

Grant Amount: Up to \$1,000.00 per project. Approximately \$10,000 is available overall for the 2019/2020 school year.

Eligible Expenses: Eligible expenses related to the overall project may include speaker fees, entrance fees, materials, or transportation.

Application Deadline: Application deadline is September 30, 2019. Grants will be announced by October 15, 2019. If you applied last year, be sure to use the current application, not last year's.
