The Audubon Society of Kalamazoo (ASK) has been a part of the Kalamazoo community since 1945, when Kalamazoo area bird watchers decided to organize. For many years it was the only all-volunteer nature organization in the Kalamazoo area. Today we are an active club, still all-volunteer, with members from all birding skill levels and age groups.

What we do:

- Offer informative monthly bird or nature programs on the 4th Monday of September-April, except in December.
- Lead over 20 birding field trips to local and regional natural areas (September-May) and, new in 2023, beginner birders' field trips will be offered.
- Publish an interesting and informative monthly e-newsletter (September-June).
- Organize a Kalamazoo Area Christmas Bird Count.
- Host a potluck and bird walk at the Annual Meeting in May.
- Give over 45 free classroom bird presentations annually and serve over 1,000 area students.
- Give a variety of community presentations on bird-related topics.
- Maintain a lending library of bird-related books.
- Maintain a local Rare Bird Alert e-mail network.
- Support the Kalamazoo Peregrine Falcon webcam and activities.
- Actively work on environmental issues, particularly on the local level.
- Take steps toward making our organization as diverse as the birds we enjoy through our Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion efforts
- Provide deserving local, national, and international organizations with donations to help protect birds and their habitats.


